**FWBBC Presents ‘Christmas on Richland’**

NASHVILLE, TN—Free Will Baptist Bible College will present its annual “Christmas on Richland” musical event Friday, December 7 on campus at 7:30 p.m. in Memorial Auditorium (3607 Richland Avenue), according to Dr. James Stevens, chairman of the Music Department. This year the Choral Union and orchestra will perform “Ceremony of Carols,” a classic 20<sup>th</sup>-century Christmas work by English composer Benjamin Britten, as well as traditional carols.

Admission to “Christmas on Richland” is free. The public is invited to join with the Free Will Baptist Bible College family of students, faculty, and staff for the annual concert.

The one-hour presentation will be under the direction of Mr. David Hahn, adjunct faculty member of conducting, music history, and voice. Mr. Hahn, director of the Nashville Philharmonic Orchestra, is also a freelance musician and composer of sacred music. This will be Mr. Hahn’s final performance before he assumes his new duties as assistant professor at Liberty University.
