**FWBBC's Forlines Lectures to Feature Dr. Russell Moore**

NASHVILLE, TN—Dr. Russell Moore, Dean of the School of Theology at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary (Louisville, Kentucky) will be the guest speaker at Free Will Baptist Bible College's 2007 Forlines Lectures set for April 10-11, according to President Matt Pinson.

“We are so pleased that Dr. Moore can be with us for this important series of lectures,” Pinson said. “He is a respected author, journalist, educator, and professional speaker who understands the challenging cultural issues and the changing world facing our students and the broader Christian community.”

Dr. Moore will speak four times in two days during expanded chapel services that will extend through the usual third hour class schedule. Chapel begins at 10:00 a.m.

*The Leroy Forlines Lectures* bring well known speakers to campus to address issues relating to theology, philosophy, world views, global evangelism, and other topics.

Russell Moore, 35-year-old Mississippi native, is the author of *The Kingdom of Christ: The New Evangelical Perspective* and co-editor of *Why I Am a Baptist*. He has written articles for various publications, including *Journal of the Evangelical Theological Society* and *Journal for Biblical Manhood and Womanhood*. He is a senior editor for *Touchstone: A Journal of Mere Christianity*.

Dr. Moore also serves as Executive Director of the Carl F.H. Henry Institute for Evangelical Engagement. He has served on the staffs of two Mississippi churches. Prior to entering the ministry, Moore was an aide to U.S. Congressman Gene Taylor.

He is a member of the Evangelical Theological Society and the Evangelical Philosophical Society. Since 1998, he has served as correspondent and columnist for Baptist Press. Moore is a Sunday School teacher, married for 13 years, and the father of three children.
