## **22 Students Attend FWBBC Senior Days II**

NASHVILLE, TN—Twenty-two students from eight states attended the second in a series of four 2008-2009 “Senior Days” events at Free Will Baptist Bible College on November 20-22, according to Jeff Caudill, director of enrollment services.
