FWBBC Alumni Choir to Rehearse GO10 Song

NASHVILLE, TN—The Alumni Choir will conduct a brief rehearsal on the Free Will Baptist Bible College campus Saturday afternoon, June 19, at 2:40 p.m. preceding the GO10 event hosted by FWBBC, according to Dr. James Stevens, chairman of the Music Department.

The volunteer choir members will meet in the first floor choir room of Davidson Hall (Music Building) to rehearse Dr. Stevens' song "Go Into All the World" which was written to recognize the legacy of Laura Belle Barnard and others in world missions outreach, and will be performed during the GO10 celebration in Memorial Auditorium at 4:00 p.m. Dr. Stevens will rehearse the accompanying orchestra members at 3:00 p.m.

"If individual Alumni Choir members can email me and let me know the parts they sing, we'll then coordinate the vocal group's strengths with the accompanying orchestra," Stevens said. "This will be an afternoon of firsts—the first time choir members sing the song publicly and the first time the orchestra plays it."
