NASHVILLE, TN—Thirty-seven years at Free Will Baptist Bible College was not enough for Mrs. Sara Steele, secretary to FWBBC’s academic dean/registrar since 1969, who announced her retirement in mid-2006. Sara’s back with a new title and now serves as Assistant to the Provost.
