**FWBBC Receives \$20,000 for Texas Student Scholarship**

NASHVILLE, TN—Free Will Baptist Bible College received a \$20,000 gift for an endowed scholarship to be named “The Texas Student Scholarship,” according to Jeff Caudill, director of enrollment services. The donors are FWBBC alumni from Texas who gave the gift to help offset education costs for Texas students at FWBBC.

President Matt Pinson said, “We are so pleased that our alumni are stepping forward at this important point in the college’s history to provide much-needed funding for scholarship endowments. We hope this encourages other alumni to consider doing something that will benefit students financially for years to come.”

Recipients of The Texas Student Scholarship must be members of a church affiliated with the Texas State Association of Free Will Baptists and have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.0. All qualified students will share in the available funds.

The donors wish to remain anonymous, and they challenge others across the denomination to add to the scholarship or start another fund to benefit students. “We have found that you can’t out-give the Lord.”
