

## Flames Come From Behind for Regional Win

*Louisville, KY.* The first half of Tuesday's game against Boyce College was an offensive struggle for FWBBC, and they trailed by 17 points going into the locker room at half-time. But the Flames stormed back in the second half to beat the Bulldogs, 63-59.

Trailing 39-22, the Flames couldn't seem to find the basket and struggled to score with two starters on the bench with two fouls each. But FWBBC came to play in the second half, outscoring Boyce by 21 points.

Several players came up big for the Flames late in the contest. Jake Manning hit three big treys in the last eight minutes, Kendred Sides hit back-to-back jumpers to take the lead for good, and Steven Terrell hit a free throw with 3.5 seconds left to make it a two possession game and seal the win.

"At half-time I told the guys to execute, that's it," said Coach Nathan Willhite. "We did not do that the first half, and it hurt us. We played a great defensive game in the second half, holding Boyce to just 20 points."

David Landers had a big night scoring 23 points and pulling down six rebounds before fouling out with five minutes left in the game. Sides added 12 points and six rebounds, while Terrell chipped in 10 points, seven rebounds, and three assists.
