FWBBC Names Jonathan Rogers Interim English Professor

NASHVILLE, TN—Dr. Jonathan Rogers has accepted a one-year interim appointment as English professor at Free Will Baptist Bible College, according to Provost Greg Ketteyman. Dr. Rogers will teach 12 hours as he assumes responsibility for courses taught by Dr. Darrell Holley who continues an emergency leave of absence to care for his mother in Florida.

Dr. Ketteyman said, “We are pleased to welcome this committed Christian scholar to the college faculty. Dr. Rogers’ doctoral focus was on 17th century English literature. He received both his M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from Vanderbilt University and taught in that institution’s English Department from 1992-1996. Since that time, he has worked as a freelance writer and editor.”

Dr. Rogers has written seven books; Thomas Nelson will publish an eighth, a biography of Flannery O’Connor, in 2012. He has also edited and/or collaborated on almost 20 books for publishers including Zondervan, Thomas Nelson, FaithWords, B&H, and Bethany House.

Dr. Rogers is married and has six children, ages 15 to 7.
