

## **Flames Pull Away Late**

The Flames had a much tougher game than expected Tuesday night, but pulled out an 81-74 win over visiting Boyce College.

The game was played on relatively even terms for 36 minutes. The Flames made big plays down the stretch and put the game out of reach for the Bulldogs.

Early in the game, the Flames built a 10-point lead, only to see Boyce make a run to get within a bucket. It set the tone for the evening as that same scenario played out several times. But the Flames were not to be denied and made their final push with four minutes left to seal the victory.

“We didn’t play as good a defense as I would have liked,” said Coach Nathan Willhite. “They got too many layups, and Etheridge (Trey) was able to hit seven 3-pointers. Fortunately, we played tougher defense at the end.”

Steven Terrell, David Landers, and Jabbar Grayson had 18 points each to lead the Flames. Kendred Sides chipped in 12 points. Landers had nine rebounds and Terrell had eight. Terrell and Sides had five assists each.
