

Flames Win One, Lose Two

Thursday, the Flames traveled to Appalachian Bible College and came away with an 81-55 win. FWBBC led by 10 at the half, but went on a big run to open the second half and secure the win. With such a big lead, Coach Willhite played his bench the final 12 minutes, as everyone on the team got into the scoring column. David Landers led scorers with 18 points, and Kendred Sides chipped in 14. Jabbar Grayson had 12 points.

Four Flames scored in double figures Friday against OCU, but it wasn't enough, and they fell 109-71. Once again, it was Landers leading the way with 16 points and Sides with 11. Grayson and Steven Terrell scored 10 each.

Saturday was a repeat of the Kentucky Christian game of two weeks ago. Down nine at half, the Flames cut the Knights lead to one with five minutes left, but weren't able to complete the comeback and lost 91-81.

Sides had a huge offensive game, scoring 34 points. Terrell had a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds. Landers scored 11 points and dished a team-high eight assists. Cody Truett was also in double digits with 12 points.

"It was a long weekend for us," said Coach Willhite. "It is always hard to make that north swing because of the distance and playing three games in three days. I was proud of how hard we worked."
