

Flames Win on Senior Day

It was “Senior Day” on Saturday as FWBBC hosted Appalachian Bible College and came away with a 98-59 victory. The game started out with both teams exchanging buckets the first eight minutes. From that point, it was all Flames, as they reeled off 16 unanswered points and the rout was on. FWBBC had balanced scoring with 45 first-half points and 53 for the second 20 minutes.
