Michael Oliver, FWBBC Men's Resident Director, Shifts Focus

NASHVILLE, TN—Reverend Michael Oliver, who completes two years as men's resident director at Free Will Baptist Bible College in May, announced plans to shift his FWBBC ministry focus this summer. Oliver plans to invest more time and effort in the college's Institutional Advancement Office where he currently serves as administrative assistant.

"My family and I had a wonderful experience working with the young men in FWBBC's Goen Hall," Oliver said. "We watched with joy as dozens of teen-aged boys enrolled as freshmen and matured as serious students and Christian gentlemen these past two years. We faced a number of challenges and opportunities, and God gave us grace for it all."

Oliver completed studies for his bachelor's degree in General Christian Ministries in December 2010 and will graduate in May. Michael, his wife Kim, and sons Seth (12) and Jon-Albert (9) plan to relocate from Goen Hall to a new parsonage now under construction at Stony Point Free Will Baptist Church in Vanleer (Tennessee) where Oliver pastors. He will commute daily to FWBBC.

David Williford, vice president for institutional advancement, said, "For the past two years, Michael has worn a lot of hats—full-time college student, pastor, resident director, administrative assistant for the Advancement Office, as well as husband and father. He first joined the Advancement Office in 2008, and we look forward to again having more of his time and attention. He's a great asset to the college and a fine example as an employee."
